

Pre-Approval Form for Honors Options Not on a Transcript

For students who wish to obtain honors units for projects about which they have doubts or for those not appearing on a transcript.

Description of project: This section should include the details of your project. Include the timeframe. If a paper is included, how long will it be? Be specific.

Objectives: What specific, attainable skills or knowledge will you gain as a result of completing this endeavor? How will your learning be augmented?

Explanation: How do your objectives relate to your major, course material or proposed career?

Methods: How will you convey what you have learned? Is there a paper? Presentation?

Evaluation: How will your project be evaluated? What criteria will be used?

After completing the honors option project, students should file a project report entailing the following points with the Honors Program. These questions are the same as those on the pre-approval form, but your answers for the final report should demonstrate your experiences, insights and conclusions.

Description of project: This section should include the details of your project including the timeframe. Be specific.

Objectives: What specific, attainable skills or knowledge did you gain as a result of completing this endeavor? How has your learning been augmented?

Explanation: How do your objectives relate to your major, course material or proposed career?
